All dogs presented by Junior Handlers must have a regular UKC reg. number, a valid Temporary Listing number, Limited Privilege or Performance listing number. They may be spayed or neutered and must be at least six months of age. No females in season may be shown in Junior Showmanship.

CLASS ELEVAGE

The Class Elevage [Breeder's Class] will consist of entries of a minimum of 3 dogs per team. You may include more dogs if you have them but there may be no more than five dogs per team. All dogs must have been produced by the same breeder but do not necessarily have to be related to each other (although that presumably could be highly likely); nor do they have to be currently owned by the breeder. The purpose of this class is to judge the CONSISTENCY of the dogs produced by that breeder. At least two of the 3 dogs must be entered in a regular class in the show. (Spayed or Neutered dogs may be included, but no more than one dog on a team of 3; or two dogs on a team of 4 or 5 may be altered.)

The teams will be separated by VARIETY although both varieties will compete in the same class, at the same time; but there is no

distinction by sex so dogs of either or both sexes can be presented on a team. Therefore, a breeder could have more than one team entered; i.e. one team of all Orange and White dogs, and a second team of all “Other Color” dogs. If a breeder has a sufficient number of dogs in one variety (more than 5), they may enter more than one team per variety as long as each team has at least 3 dogs per team. Each team will be considered as a separate entry and will be judged separately.

TOTAL DOG

To be eligible for this award, a dog must meet the requirements listed below.

1. Compete in conformation with competition and win one of the following classes
 - a. Best Male/Female of Variety
 - b. Best Male/Female
 - c. Best of Winners
 - d. Champion
 - e. Grand Champion
 - f. Best of Breed
 2. Earn a qualifying score in a licensed class at UKC Performance Event (Field Trial – Pass or Higher) on December 15, 2023

SHOW HOURS: Official confirmation will begin on Thursday, September 14th at 7:00am, the show will begin at 11:30 AM on Thursday, December 14, 2023.

Dogs are not required to be at the show until scheduled time of judging. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Mailed entries must be received by **December 1st**, to qualify for pre-entry fee.

Day of Show Entries will be accepted between the hours of 8:00 –9:30 AM.

Advance Entry Fee: Licensed Classes - \$20

Junior Showmanship, Novice Puppy - \$5; Class Elevage - \$30 (per team)

Day of Show Entries (Licensed Classes)- \$30; Jr. Show, Novice Puppy - \$10 Class Elevage - \$40 (per team)

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

1. All events are held under the Rules and Regulations of the United Kennel Club, Inc.
2. Absolutely no alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs will be allowed on the grounds or in the buildings on the day of a UKC licensed event.
3. UKC, CEB-US, their agents, and employees assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by spectators or by exhibitors and handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children not under the control of their parents or guardians. UKC/CEB-US are not responsible for loss, accidents or theft.
4. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
5. No smoking in all buildings and areas designated as such.
6. Exhibitors and dog owners are expected and required to clean up after their own dogs. Any person witnessing a violation of this rule must report it to the Event Committee. The Event Committee may ask any person violating this rule to leave the event grounds. No refund will be made if an exhibitor is asked to leave the grounds.
7. UKC will vigorously support any motel that files a complaint about exhibitors who fail to keep their dogs quiet or to clean up after them. In order that the bad conduct of a few exhibitors does not spoil it for the majority of responsible exhibitors, UKC will take strong disciplinary action against any offenders.
8. UKC encourages exhibitors to present their dogs with the least amount of grooming necessary to enable a Judge to properly compare each dog with the standard of its breed. Dogs should be clean, with nails cut to a length suitable for the dog to perform the work for which it was bred, and with clean teeth. The Judge's determination that this rule has been violated shall be final. UKC enforces rules against artificially altering pigment and coat color, coat texture, and surgical alterations as outlined in the UKC Rules and Regulations.
9. Dogs may not be left unattended when crated in soft mesh crates. No dog may be left in an unlatched or un-zippered crate.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Show grounds will be open to exhibitors at 8:00 a.m. Overnight security is not provided, and no dog(s) may not be left on the grounds overnight. All times are Central Standard Time.
2. No smoking in all buildings and areas designated as such
3. No admission or parking fees.

ENTRY ELIGIBILITY

1. Dogs must be permanently registered with UKC as Epagneul Bretons, have a Temporary Listing (TL) number, or have a Limited Privilege (LP) listing number by the closing date and time in order to enter. No exceptions will be made. Entries for ineligible dogs will be returned.
2. An un-entered dog may not be substituted for an entered dog.

SUBMITTING ENTRIES

1. Entries may be submitted on the Official UKC Entry Form included with this Premium List or on any current official UKC Entry Form. Downloaded copies or photocopies of these forms may be used as well.

2. Advance entries may be mailed or hand-delivered to the Show Secretary.
3. Mailed entries received without fees will not be accepted.
4. Advance entries must be received by the closing date and time: **midnight on 12/1/2023.**
5. A separate CEB-US Class Elevage Entry form must be completed for all team entries in that class. See the guidelines for entering the Class Elevage under "CLASSIFICATIONS" above.

ENTRY INFORMATION

1. Advance Entry Fee (mail or hand-delivered) Entry Fee Licensed Classes -\$20; Junior Showmanship and Novice Puppy - \$5, Class Elevage - \$30 per team.
2. Advance Entry Deadline: Advance entries will be accepted by the Show Secretary Patty Lucasey until December 1, 2023. Mail Advance entries to: Patty Lucasey, PO Box 20, Loami, Illinois 62661.
3. **Day of Show entries will be accepted between the hours of 8:00 –9:30AM, December 14, 2023. Day of Show fees: (Licensed Classes)- \$30; Jr. Show, Novice Puppy -\$10 Class Elevage-\$40 (per team)**

PAYMENT

1. Payment may be made by cash, check, or money order. No entry will be accepted without payment. 2. Make checks and money orders payable to CEB-US. Checks and money orders must be payable in U.S. funds. Cash will be in US currency.
3. Post-dated checks or returned checks do not constitute valid entry fees. CEB-US will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check or money order. Exhibitors who repeatedly submit invalid entry fees may be put on a CASH ONLY basis.

REFUNDS

1. No refund of entry fees will be made for entries canceled after the Advance Entry deadline.
2. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Event Committee.
3. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the host organization it is impossible to open or to complete a show or trial, no refund of entry fee will be made.
4. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries before processing. If a duplicate entry is processed, however, no refund will be made.
5. If, in the opinion of the host club, the well-being of dogs, exhibitors or spectators is at risk due to extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, or extreme heat, the host club may cancel or stop a show or trial before completion. No refunds will be made in such cases.

ENTRY CONFIRMATION

Written confirmation of entries will be made by email, as soon as practicable after receipt of Advanced Entries. If you do not receive your confirmation by the Saturday preceding this event, please notify the Show Secretary, Patty Lucasey at ceb.us.post7@gmail.com or (217)652-5430. Receipt of email entries will be acknowledged immediately by return email but this does not constitute confirmation of the entry. Entry will be confirmed upon receipt of the appropriate entry fees.

CLASS CHANGE/CORRECTION OF ENTRY

1. Owners are responsible for the accuracy of information in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors. Owners and exhibitors are responsible for correcting any errors in their entry.
2. Dogs that, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a title after the closing of entries may be transferred from the entered class to another class for which the dog is now eligible, provided that a request for transfer is made in writing to the show secretary not later than half an hour prior to the start of regular judging at the show.
3. All other corrections to entries must be made in writing to the show secretary not later than half an hour prior to the start of regular judging at the show.

ARMBANDS

One armband will be assigned to each entered dog for all shows and trials in which the dog is entered for the weekend. Armbands can be picked up at the Field Trial headquarters or from the Show Secretary on the day of the show. If you lose your armband or it gets destroyed, you can see the Show Secretary for a replacement.

SHOW TIME

Show judging will begin at 11:30 AM, Thursday, 12/14/23.

CONFIRMING OF DOGS

Cost for Confirmation

Members of the CEB-US : \$20 per dog

Non-Members of the CEB-US : \$50 for the first dog, \$20 for every dog after that.

For non members your first dog includes a one year membership to the CEB-US

Dogs may be confirmed to be within the Breed Standard in accordance with CEB-US Confirming Guidelines PRIOR to the show at 7 AM on December 14, 2023. An application for *Performance of Evaluation for Basic Conformation and for Publication of Conformation Rating* must be completed; a copy of the dog's UKC Pedigree or Easy Entry Card MUST be provided; and the applicable fee must be presented before the confirming will be conducted. Preference will be given to applications that are submitted in **advance** so you are strongly encouraged to submit your application to Tasha Pleskac, 9610 175th St. NE, Foley, MN, 56329. **Late requests will be handled on a first come/time availability basis the day of the event.**

- 2) A copy of the Épagneul Breton's Official UKC Pedigree or UKC Easy Entry Card,
- 3) The application fee. (Send to the designated club representative as noted on the event premium)

B. CEB-US Publication of Overall Conformation Ratings. Overall ratings shall be assigned only for dogs entered in CEB-US/UKC licensed Épagneul Breton National Specialty or Super Specialty Shows. The overall rating categories are: Excellent C1, Very Good C2, Good C3 and Insufficient. The overall rating of dogs receiving a rating greater than Insufficient shall be recorded in the Associations database, and published on the CEB-US Official Website and/or semi-annual Magazine.

Owner's Certification/Authorization:

In consideration of payment of the applicable application fee, the undersigned owner of the referenced UKC Registered Épagneul Breton requests that a Basic Conformation Evaluation be performed upon the designated dog, and that the results of such evaluation be reduced to writing. The undersigned further affirms:

- 1) That the dog evaluated is the dog referenced in Section (2) above and that the dog is intact and NOT NEUTERED,
 - 2) That the dog is or will be permanently registered by the United Kennel Club, Inc. as an Épagneul Breton prior to any certification being issued by CEB-US to finalize the results of the evaluation, and
 - 3) That the dog is at least one (1) year of age when the requested evaluation was performed.
- In consideration of the basic evaluation for of conformation being performed outside the show ring, and in the event that the dog is subsequently shown in a UKC licensed Épagneul Breton Specialty Show and assigned an overall rating (or previously assigned an overall rating in France), the undersigned understands, agrees and authorizes CEB-US to record the dog's overall rating in the Association's Official Database of Épagneul Bretons Rated for Conformation and/or to publish same on the Association website and magazine so long as such rating is greater than Insufficient.
- Owner/applicant for all dogs receiving a rating greater than Insufficient further authorizes CEB-US to cause such rating to be placed upon the dog's Official UKC Registration and Pedigree maintained by the United Kennel Club, Inc. at any such future time as the UKC may agree to record such information.
